Isamac - Mr. Miles called me; I share some of Karen's concerns. I would like to see the plan first. Mr. Miles must still make plans;

Mr. Miles addressed the board. Currently there are 8 positions open. His proposal is to fill the positions with people who have a great deal of experience in urban education. All have been through training with Mutiu. They have the same philosophy; organizational health for new superintendent, extensive knowledge in all school districts.

Jim Washington spoke at this time. Strategic Plan speaks to what is in the best interest of the community. We need individuals to put order to what is currently chaos. We have a lot to do in a short period of time. Our best opportunity is to contract individuals to make decisions without bargaining agent, etc. Jim supports this.

Isamac agrees, but not on every point. It addresses that we must move forward together. Their ability to connect with the district is a concern. She doesn't feel that all these don't need to be filled. She needs justifications on the two assistant superintendents and special education.

Stella will support the resolution.

John Santoro - we are not hiring anyone. We are not filling positions; we are evaluating. That's why we are doing this per diem. We are also saving money.

Karen – But this is a whole school year. There are certain positions we know he needs. She wants to wait for the strategic plan before this is done.

Keith Stamm - he's ready to vote; call for the question.

Joe Breton - UP TO 200 days or until a replacement is appointed.

Yvonne - you have nine committed board members who care about the district. Who will be pivotal. Mr. Miles and I have had a conversation regarding this; he has been asked to turn the district around in a short time. Time is not on our side; there is a timeline here. At any given time, the board can with notice. We don't rest on our laurels with regard to the filling of those positions.

FIN-183 DETERMINATION, COLLECTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF REALTY TRANSFER TAX.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Reading School District that a realty transfer tax and other tax related provisions pursuant to Article XI-D of the Tax Reform Code of 1971 is hereby enacted, which authorizes, in part, the Department of Revenue of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to determine, collect and enforce the tax.

Section 1. Imposition of Tax.

The Reading School District adopts the provisions of Article XI-D of the Tax Reform Code of 1971 and imposes a realty transfer tax as authorized under that Article subject to the rate limitations therein. The tax imposed under this Section shall be at the rate of **five** percent (5%) shared with the local municipality **and the state**. The Reading School District receives .5% and the local municipality receives 3.5% **and the state receives 1%**.

Section 2. Administration.

The tax imposed under Section 1 shall be administered, collected and enforced under the Act of December 31, 1965 (P.L. 1257, N. 511, as amended, known as "The Local Tax Enabling Act"; provided, that if the correct amount of the tax is not paid by the last date prescribed for timely payment, the Reading School District, pursuant to Section 1102-D of the Tax Reform Code of 1971 (72 P.S.§8102-D) authorizes and directs the Department of Revenue of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to determine, collect and enforce the tax.

Section 3. Repeal.

Any prior Resolutions of the Reading School District are repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with the terms and conditions stated herein.

Section 4. Effective Date.

The provisions of this Resolution shall become effective on and be applicable to any document made, executed, delivered, accepted or presented for recording on or after July 1, 2008.

- 2. take such action as deemed appropriate by the Administration and Special Construction Counsel to defend any claims brought by any party to the declaratory judgment action, including joinder of any parties who may be alone liable, liable with or liable over to the District for such claims and seeking consolidation of all such claims in one ligation;
- 3. at a time deemed appropriate by the Administration and Special Construction Counsel, commence construction industry mediation with McKissick Associates, P.C. to resolve claims not arising from the claims of the prime contractors; and
- 4. notify Gooseworks, Inc. that the District elects consolidated, construction industry mediation to resolve the claims asserted by Gooseworks, Inc. in its notice letter dated June 14, 2011, including the joinder of McKissick Associates, P.C. and The Farfield Company as parties to such mediation, provided that: (a) prior to such mediation the Administration and counsel obtain specific settlement authority from the Board of School Directors; and (b) any agreement reached in mediation shall be subject to the review and approval of the Board of School Directors in a public meeting.
