## Special Committee Meeting January 29, 2013

The special committee meeting of the Board of School Directors was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mr. Heebner, president. The meeting was held in the Board Room of the Administration Building, 800 Washington Street, Reading, PA.

Charter School Hearing	The Charter School Hearing occurred at this time. A full transcript of this hearing is on file in the Superintendent's Office and the Office of the Board Secretary.
Special Meeting	At the conclusion of the hearing, the board was called to order for a special meeting.
FINANCE AND LEGAL	Upon a motion made by Mrs. Torres-Figueroa and seconded by Mr. Storch, the board considered Resolution FIN-2, which was reintroduced from the January regular meeting.
Accelerated Budget Opt Out Resolution	FIN-2 BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors makes the following unconditional certifications:
	1. The school district's various tax levies and other revenue sources will be sufficient to balance the school district's budget for the 2013-14 fiscal year based on maintaining current tax rates or increasing tax rates by an amount less than or equal to the Act 1 index applicable to the school district as calculated by the Pennsylvania Department of Education. This conclusion is based on the school district preliminary budget or other information available to the

school board.

- 2. The applicable index for the 2013-14 fiscal year is 2.8% and the school board will not, for the 2013-14 fiscal year increase the rate of its real estate tax, or any other tax for the support of public education by an amount that exceeds the applicable index.
- 3. The school board has to date and in the future will comply with the rules set forth in School Code 687 for adoption of the school district proposed and final budgets for the next fiscal year.
